This office is located at 6 Belt Drive, Moncks Corner. Books will be open for filing January 19, 2012 at noon, and will remain open during regular business hours until February 3, 2012 at **NOON**.

#### **GENERAL ELECTION**

The Berkeley County Elections & Registration Board announces the General Election for the **City of Goose Creek** to be Tuesday, April 3, 2012.

The following offices shall be included in this election:

Three (3) City Council Seats.

The polling place for this election will be Goose Creek City Hall, 519 N. Goose Creek Blvd., Goose Creek, as set by law.

Seats are for a four (4) year term, expiring April 2016.

People desiring to vote in the upcoming election must be registered by March 2, 2012. To register, one must contact the County Board of Voter Registration & Elections.

Registered electors who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Voters wishing more information concerning absentee voting should contact their county voter registration office.

This is a nonpartisan election and no party affiliation shall be placed on the ballot.

The polls shall open at 7:00 AM on election day and close at 7:00 PM.

At 9:00 AM on election day the County Board of Elections & Registration shall begin the process of examining the absentee ballots. This examination will be held at the County Elections Office, 6 Belt Drive, Moncks Corner.

On Thursday, the 5th of April at 10:00 AM the County Elections & Registration Board will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.
