## **VISITING MIDDLETON PLACE A GUIDE FOR CHAPERONES**

As an adult chaperone, accompanying students to Middleton Place, your role is extremely important. You play an essential part in ensuring that students will have a safe, educational and entertaining experience while on their visit. In order to assist you, we ask that you follow these guidelines:

- All chaperones must be at least 21 years of age.
- Safety first! Please follow the direction of Middleton Place staff members; rules and guidelines have been put in place for your group's protection.
- Student behavior is your responsibility. Encourage your group to be respectful of other Middleton Place guests. Please respect Middleton Place's natural habitats and items of historic significance.
- Students must be chaperoned during their entire visit to Middleton Place. Please account for all of your students regularly, before changing activities, leaving the property, etc.
- Our staff members are here to help. Please provide our staff with any assistance or support, if requested. Please direct any question or concern to your tour guide or a member of the Education staff.
- As a chaperone, you may be called on to supervise a small group of students, without the assistance of a teacher. Encourage inquisitiveness and discussion within your group; the students are here to learn.
- Help your students to be good stewards of the environment. Ensure that all garbage and refuse are deposited in the appropriate receptacles before leaving the area.
